

Doxe Update Instructions

Important Before applying the update **v 2.3** make sure you are using **v 2.2** (You can check the current version to login your admin panel > footer), If you are using an older version please contact our support codericks.envato@gmail.com to get all the previous versions.

Step 1: Download the latest script from codecanyon and extract it on your pc. Open **updates > v2.3 > uploads** folder there you will see **2 zip files** in this folder and you need to upload those files in your server please follow the below directions carefully.

- **application.zip** > upload path: Goto your project **root folder** > **application** upload this zip file inside this folder and extract.
- **assets.zip** > upload path: Goto your project **root folder** > **assets** upload this zip file inside this folder and extract.

Step 2: Upload “**updates**” folder in your project root folder

Step 3: Open a browser and write a url like this: www.yourdomain.com/updates/v2.3 you will see a page like below here enter your item purchase code for update this script.
